Solvay Chemicals, Inc., manufacturer of BICAR[®] Sodium Bicarbonate, believes that based on knowledge of the manufacturing process and periodic metal analyses, our BICAR[®] Sodium Bicarbonate may contain trace levels of metals that are listed in California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65), as published as of August 1, 2019.

Lead, ppm	< 0.50
Cadmium, ppm	< 0.25
Chromium, ppm	< 12.5
Nickel, ppm	< 12.5
Mercury, ppm	< 0.75
Cobalt, ppm	< 5.0
Arsenic, ppm	< 0.75
