Re: Solvay Interrox® SG Grades – naming convention

Solvay produces INTEROX® SG grades of Hydrogen Peroxide (H₂O₂) at three sites world wide; in the USA, the Netherlands, and Thailand. All three sites use the same proprietary technology to purify H₂O₂ and to make INTEROX® SG to the same standard.

However, as Solvay is a regionally organised business the naming convention has evolved differently at each of the three sites. In the long term Solvay will rationalise the naming convention so that the names are consistent across the group, however due to regulatory filings this cannot happen quickly. In the mean time we recognise this may cause some confusion and hope to clarify the situation in the table below
